

MISSION

ACADEMICS

Cornerstone students learn basic skills, thinking skills, and content knowledge.

Basic skills are reading, communication, computation, and physical education.

Thinking skills include both creative and critical approaches to self-expression and problem-solving.

Content knowledge includes languages, mathematics, science, social studies, and health.

Chinese language instruction includes Cantonese in our Preschool and Kindergarten classes. Mandarin is taught as a foreign language in grades 1-8 daily.

Instruction is primarily in English in grades K-8.



CHARACTER BUILDING

Christian principles are the basis of good character. Weekly chapel services include Christian songs and a pastor's message, Bible stories for younger students, and Bible study for older students. These help our students grow in emotional well-being, knowledge, and wisdom. Students are encouraged to live out the principles of mutual love and respect. This builds wholesome and happy feelings towards family and friends and increases confidence as a person of worth.

COMMUNITY

Small class sizes enable a caring and supportive community at our school. Parents become a part of this community as they partner with teachers and staff to support their child's learning.



BEFORE- AND AFTER- SCHOOL CARE

Students may arrive on campus early for breakfast and stay after school to study and obtain extra help from teachers.
